

Good Evening,

This is Mrs. McIntosh and it is Thursday, September 7, 2017.

Our Hot Lunch Program will begin next Tuesday. They will be serving Hot Lunches again this year from Tuesday-Friday. In the meantime milk will be available for purchase during the lunch hour for .50 cents each. The menu should be going home with students today or tomorrow. Our Breakfast Program will also begin next week as well.

Please be advised that flags at all provincial buildings, sites, establishments and schools within the province of New Brunswick are to be lowered to half-mast from sunrise to sunset on Sunday, September 10, 2017, to recognize Firefighters' National Memorial Day. In keeping with this we will be lowering our flags from Friday evening, September 8th, and will remain at half mast until Monday morning, September 11th.

This message is for all parents or guardians of grade 7 students. Public Health nurses will be coming to our school on Friday, September 22, 2017 to offer grade 7 students vaccines. All students are eligible to receive a vaccine against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough), and a vaccine against Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Your child should have received two information pamphlets.

Please complete the consent form, and return it to your child's teacher. A signature is required for each vaccine on this form. This should be returned whether the student is being immunized or not.

Please contact the school as soon as possible if you did not receive immunization consent forms from your child. If you have any questions, please contact Public Health at 1-888-829-6444.

The meeting will start at 6:30 p.m. in the gym followed by an opportunity to meet with your child's classroom teachers. The Canadian MedicAlert Foundation has created the "No Child Without" program.

This program provides students from the age of 4 until their 14th birthday with 24 hour protection of MedicAlert emergency information services, at no cost.

Some conditions that emergency responders need to know in an emergency are

severe allergies to drugs, food or insects, needs EpiPen or Twinject, Asthma, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism, Epilepsy, Diabetes, Hemophilia, Visual or Hearing impairment, and Devices or implants.

Having MedicAlert identification can alert school staff, friends, coaches and others about your child's medical condition or special needs when it matters most.

This is to inform parents that the Kindergarten to Grade Five student fees for the 2017/2018 school year is \$25.00/student up to a maximum of \$75.00 per family. Student fees are used for student locks, agendas, cultural performances, field trips and special activities. The Gr. 6-8 student fee is \$40.00/student which is used for student locks, agendas, cultural performances, field trips, and special activities and also includes a tech fee covering consumables used in Tech class.
