### Schedule

Kindergarten - 5 classes begin every day at 8:20 am.

Secondary classes begin at 8:20. Buses load at 2:50 pm Monday – Thursday.

K-8 students are done at noon every Friday.

High School students are done at 2:50 pm every Friday except the fourth Friday of the month when they will be done at 12:00pm.

Supervision for students will begin at 8:00 am. **K-2 students have breakfast and learning centres from 8:00-8:20 and then classes begin at 8:20.** Students must not be dropped off at school prior to 8:00 am. Students must be picked up promptly after school (2:50pm) if they are not going home on the bus. If for any reason students must leave school during the school day (with the exception of 9-12 students at lunch), a parent or legal guardian must come to sign the student out at the office. Someone will meet you at the door to sign them out. Please wear a mask.

### Visitor Policy

**Parents/caregivers and community members will be asked not to enter the building during the 2020-2021 school year without an appointment.**

Parents/caregivers that are dropping off lunches or other required materials will be asked to call the school office (506-488-3500) to arrange for the drop-off of goods, and again upon arrival at the school. A staff member will pick up the item from the door and deliver the items to the student’s classroom. Parents dropping off items are asked to wear masks when they come to the door. Staff members receiving items must wear a mask and sanitize hands after handling the items.

Parents/caregivers without a cell phone will be asked to ring the doorbell at the school upon arrival.
