Dear Parents,

Over the past few weeks, ASD-W district staff have been collaborating with the administrative team at Cambridge Narrows School around student scheduling at the middle and high school level for the upcoming 2019-2020 school year.

Cambridge Narrows Community School will engage in a pilot next year related to scheduling of courses. The goals of the pilot are:

1. To allow a greater selection of course for high school students.
2. To increase instructional time for middle level students resulting in instructional time being closer to provincial guidelines set by EECD.

As a result, changes will be made to end of day busing for middle and high school students on Fridays. September 2019 will see both middle and high school level students dismissed at 2:50 p.m. on Fridays, with the exception of the fourth Friday of the month which will see all students dismissed at noon.

The district, in collaboration with school staff, will engage students and their families in a survey at the end of first semester and second semester for feedback on the new schedule and impact on learning.

Please take note the change in schedule has no impact on the school day for Kindergarten to Grade 5 students.
