

Background Information:

Schulich Leader Scholarships are prestigious entrance scholarships awarded to high school graduates enrolling in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) programs at participating partner Canadian universities (this excludes medical research and medical studies). Recognizing the increasing importance and impact that STEM disciplines will have on the prosperity of future generations, businessman and philanthropist Seymour Schulich established this \$100 million scholarship fund in 2012 to encourage students to be the next pioneers of global scientific research and innovation.

Eligibility:

To be considered for the scholarship, students must:

- Pursue an undergraduate degree in a STEM program (**not** including medical research or medical studies with plans to become a medical practitioner).
- Be a Canadian citizen.
- Be completing their final year of high school.
- Be attending one of the Schulich partner universities.

Schulich partner universities include: Universite Laval, UNB, Dalhousie, University of Victoria, York University, Queen's University, Simon Fraser University, McGill, McMaster University, University of Manitoba, University of Toronto, Universite de Montreal, University of Waterloo, Memorial University, Western, UBC, University of Ottawa, University of Saskatchewan, University of Alberta, University of Calgary

In addition to the eligibility criteria above, students must possess at least two of the three criteria:

- Attain high academic excellence.
- Have outstanding community, business, or entrepreneurial leadership experience.
- Have financial need.

Value of scholarship - Top 5 most in-demand universities:

- 2 scholarships at \$100,000 for engineering
- 2 scholarships at \$80,000 for science or math

Remaining 15 universities:

- 1 scholarship at \$100,000 for engineering
- 1 scholarship at \$80,000 for science or math

Application Procedure:

Students meeting the eligibility criteria listed above will first submit an application to be considered as the sole nominee for CNHS. The sole nominee will then be notified by guidance to complete a more detailed online application process.

To Apply to CNHS:

Write a 500 word essay demonstrating why you would make a great Schulich Leader. Outline the following: 1) your future plans regarding the STEM Program, 2) the description of your community, business, or entrepreneurial leadership, and 3) your financial need. Include in your essay, please add where you plan to go to University.

Double space your essay; use Times New Roman, 12 point font with 1" margins. Include a title.

Also submit an official copy of your transcript.

Deadline: Friday, January 11th, 2019

Submit your essay and official transcript to the Guidance Department.
