

## Quick Reminder – Steps to Apply to College and University (Post-Secondary School)

- 1) Research the details on the websites of the post-secondary schools (program admission requirements, due dates, scholarship due dates, residence application due dates, and other pertinent information).
- 2) Apply to the post-secondary institution(s) of your choice either online or on paper (most are online). It’s always a good idea to apply to more than one school.
- 3) Fill out the transcript request form at the office. The secretaries will mail, send or fax your official transcripts to the post-secondary institution(s), or they will give them to you. They will do whatever you request them to do on the form. You have to have your pink parental consent forms brought in before you can get transcripts sent.
- 4) Send in all required information to the post-secondary institution. This usually includes: application form, fee, and official transcript. Depending on the program, you might have to send in additional essays, sketches, portfolios, and so on.

\*If applying to NBCC, do so ASAP. Applications are already being assessed.

\*Try to apply to school before the scholarship deadline so you are eligible for scholarships there.

\*Applications to residences may or may not be at a later date. It depends on the school.

*Choose to go to a post-secondary school that is the right fit for you.*
