Step 1 – Place a checkmark beside the 7 compulsory courses you have already passed (received above 60%).

- *English 112 or 113 (2 credits, so check it twice if you passed it)
- English 122 or 123
- Math 11 (Financial and Workplace Math 110 or Foundations Math 110)
- Science (Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Human Physiology, Automotive Electrical Systems, or Intro to Electronics)
- Modern History 112 or 113
- Fine Arts or Life Role (Music 112 or 113 or 122, Visual Art 110, Graphic Art and Design, Outdoor Pursuits, Wellness PE, Entrepreneurship, COOP, Individual Family Dynamics)
