WHAT IS AUTISM

Autism is the common name used to describe Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). It is a complex neurobiological disorder that affects many body systems including brain development, leaving most individuals with communication problems, difficulty with typical social interactions and a tendency to repeat specific patterns of behaviour. There is also a markedly restricted repertoire of activity and interests. Individuals living with autism tend to have varying degrees and combinations of symptoms.


CHARACTERISITICS

If your child has some of these characteristics and is between 18 and 36 months of age, he or she may be showing early signs of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

- Avoids eye contact
- Seems to ignore you
- Prefers to play alone
- Has excessive tantrums
- Has poor speech or 'loses' words
- Demonstrates limited pretend play
- Has repetitive & unusual behaviour
- Has chronic diarrhea or constipation
- Does not 'show you' or 'point to' objects

If you suspect your child may have ASD, consult a physician specializing in developmental disorders immediately.

The incidence of Autism Spectrum Disorder is at epidemic proportions and is currently diagnosed in up to 1 in 68 children.



TREATMENTS AND THERAPIES

Each individual with an ASD will benefit from a broad-based approach drawing upon various treatments and therapies unique to his/her symptoms and abilities. The following are just some of the treatments and therapies currently used to manage or eliminate the symptoms of Autism Spectrum Disorders:
