Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Chair Serena Bradford at 7:02pm.

Approval of the Agenda: Brenda moved to approve the agenda with no amendments. Kim seconded. All in favour.

Approval of the Minutes from Previous Meeting: Kim noted an error, Cindy Drummond’s surname was recorded incorrectly. Brenda moved to approve the minutes as amended. Jen seconded. All in favour.

Business Arising from the Minutes:

- School meal prepared by the 11/12 FI Culinary Technology class was enjoyed by all
- Suicide awareness and prevention presentation was delivered by Canadian Mental Health Association

New Business:

- Beyond The Hurt program lead by Sarah Wood and Stacey Roy
 - grade 9 and 10 students involved
 - focused on school spirit and kindness
 - held a School Spirit Day with middle school activities and then high school activities with treats for the students. A good morale boost!
- Recycling Project
 - The blue bin at the school was taken away when the recycling program went door to door
 - It is not in the District budget to do the run
 - Two concerned grade 7 students spearheaded an investigation into what could be done to address this issue

- A meeting with the facilities assistant manager took place and it was decided that the Fall there would be a Student Impact Project where the students will look into fundraising grants that may be available for this project.
- School Improvement Plan:
 - Increase education around First Nations and cultural activities
 - Would like to invite Possesum Paul to come back
- Grant:
 - Focus on nutrition
 - Clementines
 - Fruit and vegetable day
 - Watermelon and water bottles at Relay Day
 - Leah Cain, a registered dietician, came to the school for a day and a half. Working with small groups, she taught the students about plant-based protein
 - Next year: Lynn Ann Duffley, school wellness consultant
- Orientation for Grade 5
 - Approximately 42 students are expected to be entering grade 6 from Harvey Elementary
 - Students were given a tour of the school, had lunch in the cafeteria
 - The students from the “Beyond the Hurt” program helped out
- Transition from middle school to high school for grade 8 students
 - This is a new initiative lead by Sarah Wood
 - Discuss differences between middle school and high school
- “Live Different” presentation next year
 - Price was negotiated from \$800 down to \$400
- Green & Gold performed another show
 - Made \$242, a total of almost \$600 raised and donated to Christmas Mommies
- Home and School Report:
 - Wrapped up canteens for the year with Junior Girls and Senior Boys Volleyball
 - Approximately \$500 in profits, which were matched by Home & School and donated to student who sustained a serious injury.
