**Youth Employment Fund**

The Youth Employment Fund provides an entry point to long term employment for unemployed individuals between 18-29 years of age who require a work experience opportunity. By placing an individual with an employer, the individual will gain work experience and develop skills through basic workplace training, mentoring and coaching. Graduating high school students, at least 18 years of age, who do not plan to attend postsecondary education and plan to enter the labour force immediately after high school may apply for this program after May 1. Please submit your information and
