HELP HELP! Once again our school and PSSC ask for your help in helping to keep our students safe at Hubbard. The student drop off area is a busy spot in and around the parking lot. Our PSSC is working on easing the flow of traffic, but in the meantime as drivers you need to follow the arrows out there, and watch for students. Here is what will help:

- ⇒ There are TWO LANES at the parking lot drop off.
- ⇒ **DROP OFF IS ON THE INSIDE LANE**, students get out and walk along the building, keep moving along the lane and please don't park or idle there.
- ⇒ **DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILD OFF IN THE OUTSIDE LANE.** If you need to stop your car, go park and walk with your child. Your child should never be expected to cross over the path of a vehicle. There have been close calls.
- ⇒ **SLOW DOWN** for safety sake.
- ⇒ Please do not use the staff parking area off of Mackenzie Ave. to drop off students. It is not deemed a drop off site.
- ⇒ Students being dropped off and walking should not arrive before 8:00 at which time outdoor supervision starts.
- ⇒ Mind the bus loading area. Keep it clear for buses only.

We understand that there have been several reminders about this, yet it continues to be a concern. Our PSSC has asked for support in this from both district and the RCMP. Ultimately we need you to help ensure all students are safe-including your own!
