

Home and School Meeting: March 12th 2019

1. Breakfast program: Grants/attendance/sponsorships (any words from Costco?)
 - RBC \$1,000 dollars for breakfast program. Put in school account but separate breakfast program account
 - No more donations needed from parents because we have the money
 - About 40 kids coming down on average
 - 5 volunteers from RBC coming on Tuesday, March 19
 - Always nice to have more volunteers on days for bagels (Lacey will come in Mondays before and cut the bagels)
 - Enbridge donated Costco gift card \$250.
 - Haven't heard from Costco yet re- donation
 - Canada post foundation \$5,000 dollar grant for breakfast program
 - Will be looked into by PSSC as a group (Amanda and Helga)
 - Possibly license the kitchen for future grants
 - Power bar needed for breakfast program for toasters (Helga will purchase with Costco card)
2. Activities/Fundraisers March-June
 - Movie nights
 - April 12th : Hop or Easter movie
 - May 24th? Tentative depending on numbers.
 - Swimming: what grades will be participating?
 - Grade 4/5 class can go swimming at the middle school.
 - May 7th, 14th, 21st, 30th (final swim) then grade 5 will do Middle School tour/lunch, grade 4s will do library visit.
 - Home and school will pay for bussing.
 - York Care
 - Grade 1/ 2 on March 29th
 - Home and school will pay bussing
 - Multigenerational grant from iHub
 - Collaborate with Leo Hayes. 20 of our kids, 20 of theirs and 20 residents
 - Meet at Leo Hayes, after second visit at York care Leo Hayes will come to us and make craft for residents
 - The first visit they will play bingo, second visit make slime, third visit will have a walk back to McAdam Ave and then a picnic.
 - Fundraisers: Popcorn, coffee java moose?
 - Not needed.
 - Color run (June?)
 - Tentative date June 8th, rain date June 15th
 - Reaching out to FredKid getting involved they can sell our tickets and help with advertising. Also will give us more volunteers
 - Sending information letter out to parents to gather a committee. (Amanda)
 - We have powder left but Amanda will order some more.
