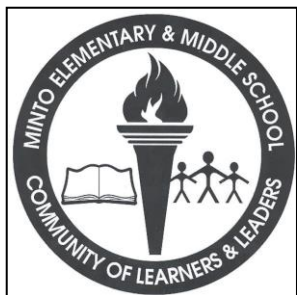

MEMS Primary Level School Supplies 2017 - 2018

For Students Entering Kindergarten to Grade 2

Primary level teachers request a \$30 school supply fee to purchase supplies for the class. Supplies will be purchased by the teachers over the summer. The following list is a guideline of what will be purchased for each child.

- 3 two pocket portfolios (plain with no picture)
- 4 white vinyl erasers
- 16 duo tangs in a variety of colors - Please do not label them (3 red, 3 blue, 3 green, 3 yellow, 2 purple, 2 orange)
- 2 packages (24) wax CRAYOLA crayons
- 1 package of Crayola fine tip markers
- 1 package (8) of Crayola original thick markers
- 1 package of pencil crayons (*Laurentien or Crayola*)
- 2 packages (10) of HB pencils
- 2 Hilroy Journals or Exercise books $\frac{1}{2}$ plain $\frac{1}{2}$ lined- (72 pages)
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 2 Construction Paper Packages - all one colour (not a pad)
- 1 box of large "Ziploc" bags
- 1 box of small "Ziploc" bags (100)
- 4 large glue sticks (*ie: UHU stick*)
- 1 mini white board
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 mini coil notebook
- 1 package of scribblers

Please Note:

Some of these supplies will be pooled together to be used at our classroom tables, especially the pencils, crayons & markers. All of these items are available at Staples in the Fredericton Mall. Sales usually start near the middle of August.

Students will need a change of footwear for inside the school - one pair of sneakers which they could wear for Physical Education (*with soles that do not mark*) would be fine.

Students are absolutely not permitted to bring or use liquid paper or correction fluid to school. Dry erase correction tapes (or pen erasers) are acceptable.

MEMS Student Fees For All K - 8 Students

In addition to the school supplies, **MEMS** collects a \$ 30.00 (\$ 60.00/family) student fee for all **Kindergarten to Grade 8** students. This is collected during the **first school week in September** and will cover the cost of student agenda handbooks, locks for lockers, and supplementary materials to enhance the classroom learning environment.
