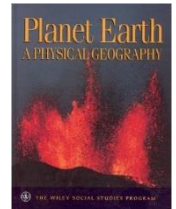




PHYSICAL GEOGRAPHY 110

Welcome to Mr. Davis' Physical Geography Class! This course runs for one semester and is designed for students who are interested in the Earth, how it came to be, and the unique features of our planet. The following is important information for you and your parent/guardian to read. There is a section to be filled out by a parent or guardian and is to be return to myself for updated contact information.

Textbook: *Planet Earth: A Physical Geography* - Students will be assigned a textbook; however their textbook is expected to remain in the class. If for some reason a student needs to take a textbook home, they may sign one out and return it when they are finished.

2. The Earth in Space
3. The Structure of the Earth
4. From Continental Drift to Plate Tectonics
5. Map Photo and Satellite Image Interpretation

Expectations:

As well, there will be daily work presented that may or may not be worth marks; however to be successful in the course you should complete all work presented.

Updates and assignments: This course and others I teach will be updated periodically on the school website. Please check from time to time for new assignments or upcoming tests. If you are absent for a day or more it is the expectation that you go to the website to see what you have missed.
