

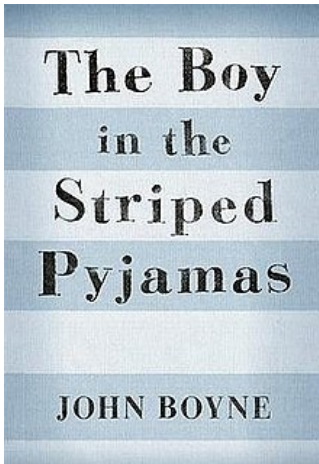

The challenge this week, we will fold and adjust planes to try and make them fly as far as possible. Watch the videos included in the PDF to become an expert plane folder and learn about the forces that make your plane SOAR!

John Collins (the man who folded the World Record plane) says that people think they don't know how to fold a good paper airplane, but they are WRONG. They just don't know how to ADJUST a paper airplane! Fold your plane following the designs in the video, then test the plane. Make adjustments to improve the distance of the plane and note the observations as you go.
