Weekly Continuation of Learning Plan for Grade 8 Social Studies April 6 – 9

Outcome: Explore your concept of world view and explain the factors that influence and are influenced by it.

This week our learning plan will involve you asking questions and finding the answers to events that are happening in the world today that impact Atlantic Canada.

Activity

- 1. Start by creating a journal where you will record your questions, wonderings, answers about the news you explored.
- 2. Each day, listen to a reputable news source such as CBC or CTV Atlantic for at least 15 minutes . You can also access these sources by going to their websites: https://www.cbc.ca/news/canada/new-brunswick or https://atlantic.ctvnews.ca/
- 3. Daily, record what you discovered from exploring the news sources.
- 4. Here is a list of questions you can consider when you listen or watch the news:
- a. Who are the Premiers of the Atlantic provinces?
- b. Who are the Chief Medical Officers for each province? What messages are they sharing with Atlantic Canadians? What are the similarities in these messages? What are the differences?
- c. How are their messages similar to the news from around the world right now?
- d. At the end of the week, summarize your daily journal entries by answering this question: What specific world issue do you think is affecting Atlantic Canada and what is the impact of this situation?

You can also draw your responses or record them.

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
