Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Millville Elementary School:

As stated in my May 27<sup>th</sup> and September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 letters to you, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of Millville Elementary School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

Millville Elementary School is a "triggered" school for study as it has an enrolment of less than 100 students.
