Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Nackawic Elementary, Middle and High Schools:

On May 21, 2015, the Anglophone West District Education Council (DEC) voted in favour of engaging a sustainability study of Nackawic Elementary, Middle and High Schools, as a cluster, under the process of Provincial Policy 409 – Multi-Year School Infrastructure Planning. This policy serves as a foundation for determining the sustainability of a school, taking into account many aspects, such as:

- Enrolment
- Health and Safety
- Quality Education
- Transportation
- Impact on Community
- Finances
- Economic Development
- Impact on Other Schools

On January 28, 2016, the DEC held the third public meeting in this process. At that meeting, the Council voted in favour of maintaining the status quo at the Nackawic Elementary, Middle and High Schools. This decision is also communicated with the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development.

It should be noted that, in a corresponding study, the DEC passed a motion to recommend to the Minister that the students of Millville Elementary School be moved to Nackawic Elementary School. This recommendation will be considered by the Minister within the next 60 days.

In line with Provincial Policy 409, there is no need for the Minister to approve the vote of DEC to maintain the status quo. As such, the sustainability study is now complete and classes will continue, as is, at Nackawic Elementary School, Nackawic Middle School and Nackawic High School.
