Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Nackawic Elementary, Middle and High Schools:

As stated in my May 27th, 2015, letter to the parents of Nackawic Elementary, Nackawic Middle and Nackawic High Schools, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of the Nackawic Schools as a cluster, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-Year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

On September 30th, 2015, I wrote to parents with an invitation to attend Public Meeting #2, scheduled for November 24th, 2015. I write to you today with a **change in date for this meeting**. You might recall that this meeting will provide an opportunity for parents, PSSC and stakeholders to present their ideas regarding the sustainability of the Nackawic Schools in a public forum. Details of the meeting are included in that September 30th letter, which can also be found on our website in the Nackawic Sustainability Study section.
