$\checkmark$ Tell you stories (e.g., "I went to preschool and we had a snack. I didn't like it")
$\checkmark$ Do 3 things in a row (e.g., " go get your coat and your hat and meet me at the van")
$\checkmark$ Guess the ending of a story (e.g., " I don't think that the big bad wolf can blow down the brick house")
$\checkmark$ Talk so most people understand me. I may not say 's', 'r', 'sh', 'ch', 'l', 'th' words.
$\checkmark$ Talk without stuttering
$\checkmark$ Have fun playing with kids my age
$\checkmark$ Answer questions (e.g., "Why do you brush your teeth?")
$\checkmark$ Tell you some letters in my name (i.e, "My name is John. My first letter is J")
$\checkmark$ Play rhyming games (i.e, "Cat and Hat, they rhyme")
$\checkmark$ Play a game with you. (e.g., Go Fish, an easy board game)
$\checkmark$ Read a longer story with you. (i.e, The Three Little Pigs)

## Things we can do together...

$\checkmark$ Read signs when we are out (e.g., stop signs, Tim Hortons)
$\checkmark$ Cook together using a recipe. Talk about what we should put in first, next and last. Point to the words in the recipe.
