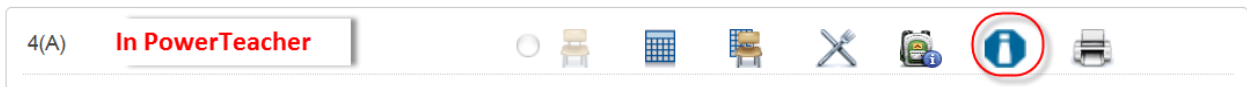


How to Indicate PLP, Individualized and Modified
