Making a Balloon Rocket

Learn about propulsion.



Materials

- · long balloon
- · thin string or yarn
- large straw with a short piece cut off
- tape
- · measuring tape

Procedure

- 1. Place the string or yarn through the longer piece of straw. Attach the string or yarn to each side of the room.
- 2. Blow up the balloon. Do not let the air out. You may wish to use something to clamp the neck of the balloon closed.
- 3. Tape the longer piece of straw to the balloon, making sure not to let the air out of the balloon.
- 4. Place the shorter piece of straw into the neck of the balloon and tape it into place.
- 5. Stand at one end of the room and let the air out of the balloon. As the air rushes out, the balloon should travel along the string or yarn.
- Launch your balloon rocket three times. Use the measuring tape to see how far your balloon rocket moves each time. Record your measurements on the back of this paper.
