Use your RazKids account to read at your current level – do not forget the comprehension tests.	Use your Prodigy math account to practice your math skills.
Read the newspaper, magazines, articles online and tell a family member what they were about.	Write out all your times tables facts 1-9. Examples 1x1=9.... 6x5=30... 9x 7 = 63...
Use website www.ixl.com and work on grade level Language Arts skills.	Write out all your division facts 1-9. Example 9÷9=1... 48÷6=8... 10÷2=5...
Write a story. Do a Brainstorm, write a Draft, Edit/Revise, and Write a good copy . Read it to your family!	Use website www.ixl.com and work on grade level Math skills.
Look at all the Nouns (people, places, thing) in your home and give an Adjective (word that describes a noun) to describe it.	Have a family member test your mental math skills on addition and subtraction.
Look at all the Verbs (action words) going on in your home and give an Adverb (words that describe verbs) to describe it.	Use a tape measurer to find Area and Perimeter of different objects (Area = Length x Width. Perimeter = Length + Length + Width + Width).
Read a book, newspaper article, something you found on the internet to a family member.	Look for all the numbers you can find around your home or see on the internet/television and write that number in Expanded Form (ex. 1245 = 1000+200+40+5).
Look up a work on the internet you heard or read somewhere during the day you do not know and find the definition for that word.	Look for all the number you can find around your home or see on the internet/television and write that number in Written Form (ex. 1245 = one thousand two hundred forty-five).
