Kindergarten Registration

Hot Lunch

Our Hot Lunch Program started the week of September 24. We are offering Hot Lunch 4 days a week this year - Deli Subs (Turkey and Ham) on Monday, Chicken Snackers on Tuesday, Pizza on Wednesday and Hamburgers on Thursday. Milk is offered all 5 days. Our suppliers this year are Chef Frank (he does the River Valley Middle School lunches) who is supplying us the chicken snackers, hamburgers and pizza. Subway is our supplier for the Subs.

Hot Lunch orders are processed monthly. All orders/money must be in by <u>9 am on Wednesday morning of designated date on the form</u>. Payment can be made by cheque, please make it payable to <u>"Morna Heights Home and School"</u>. If you are paying by cash, you must have correct amount of money, no change will be provided. If you have more than one child in the school you can send in one payment but, please make sure the orders are sent in separate baggies/envelopes as orders are collected by class, thank you. Credits are only offered on days that school is cancelled or if there is an error with an order. It is up to parents to write the credit on the form.
