<u>Fluoride</u>



Our fluoride program is up and running. Each child who participates in the program will rinse with a 0.2% neutral sodium fluoride mouth rinse once a week. Permission slips have been sent home. Please make sure your child has returned their form - thank you!

Emergency Evacuation Procedure Information



Anglophone South School District and Morna Heights School has a primary responsibility to ensure the safety of students and staff inside school buildings and while on school property. As a result, all schools in the district have an Emergency Procedure Plan which include fire drills, evacuation to an alternate site as well as external and internal lockdown procedures.

In the event that a school must be evacuated, the children will be taken to the KBM Club House and remain there until the situation has been assessed. If we are unable to return to the school we will contact all parents. Buses will operate from the KBM and walkers will be sent home.

A school lockdown is initiated should a high risk incident involving weapons, hazardous chemical spill, severe weather warning, student/other intruder, etc. occur in the schools or on school property, or if there are circumstances in the vicinity of the school that could endanger the safety of students and staff.

In order for all students and staff to become familiar with the expectations during a lockdown, our school will be practicing emergency lockdown procedures on a regular basis, as we do with fire drills. During these drills there will be signs posted on the entrance doors indicating that the school is in lockdown. The doors will be locked and no one will be permitted to enter or leave the school during these exercises. This is the same procedure that will be followed in a real situation.

Teachers will talk to their students and practice before we do a school wide exercise. These lockdown procedures only take a few minutes to practice.

Following are reminders about the Hot Lunch Program. 1) Please make sure the order forms and payment are received back at the school by the due date on the form. 2) If you have your child filling out the form please make sure their name is on all forms and double check that the selections and totals are correct. 3) If your child is ordering a Pita the Pita Pit order form that is attached to the Hot Lunch form must be filled out as they are specially ordered. If this order form is not filled out the Pita will come plain. Please note the Pita Pit order form is for <u>Pita Pit only</u>. 4) Also, please note that you must order milk on the hot lunch form, you <u>cannot</u> buy milk on a daily or weekly basis. Thank you for your cooperation.

As the winter months are approaching, credits are only offered on days that school is cancelled or if there is an error with an order. It is up to parents to write the credit on the form.
