


#### Barnhill Celebrates Black History: Daniel Williams Performed the First Open Heart Surgery in North America



An African American doctor, in 1891, Williams opened Provident Hospital, the first medical facility to have an interracial staff. He was also one of the first physicians to complete **open heart surgery** on a patient successfully. Williams later became chief surgeon of the Freedmen's Hospital.


