

Through the month of February, we are tracking student preparedness.



There is a scent reduced policy in all Anglophone South Schools. This means there should be no scents sprayed or used within the school environment unless it is a deodarant stick.




STAFF APPRECIATION WEEK

This week, remember to let a staff member at Barnhill know how much they mean to you.




VALENTINES DANCE

If you want to sign in someone, please do so with Ms. Ferguson before noon on February 12th.



The First recorded Black man in Canada became a National Hero

- Back in the 1600s, an intelligent young man arrived on the shores of Canada. Well, what someday would be known as Canada. This man spoke and understood at least five different languages!
- He was also the first recorded Black person, or person of African heritage, to visit and live on this land.
- Mathieu's language skills were valuable and in demand. He worked with well-known French explorers like Samuel de Champlain and Pierre Dugua de Mons. Which meant he was part of many trade and exploration **expeditions** (or journeys).
- As an interpreter, he would translate languages for explorers and First Nations people in New France (Quebec).




Just like tending to a garden, together we can each help nurture a sense of belonging where we live, work, and go to school.
