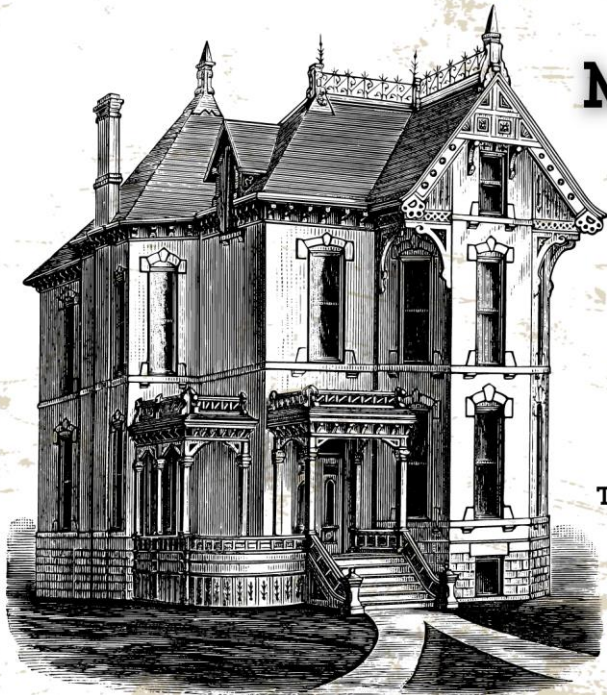

International Day Against Homophobia, Transphobia, and Biphobia

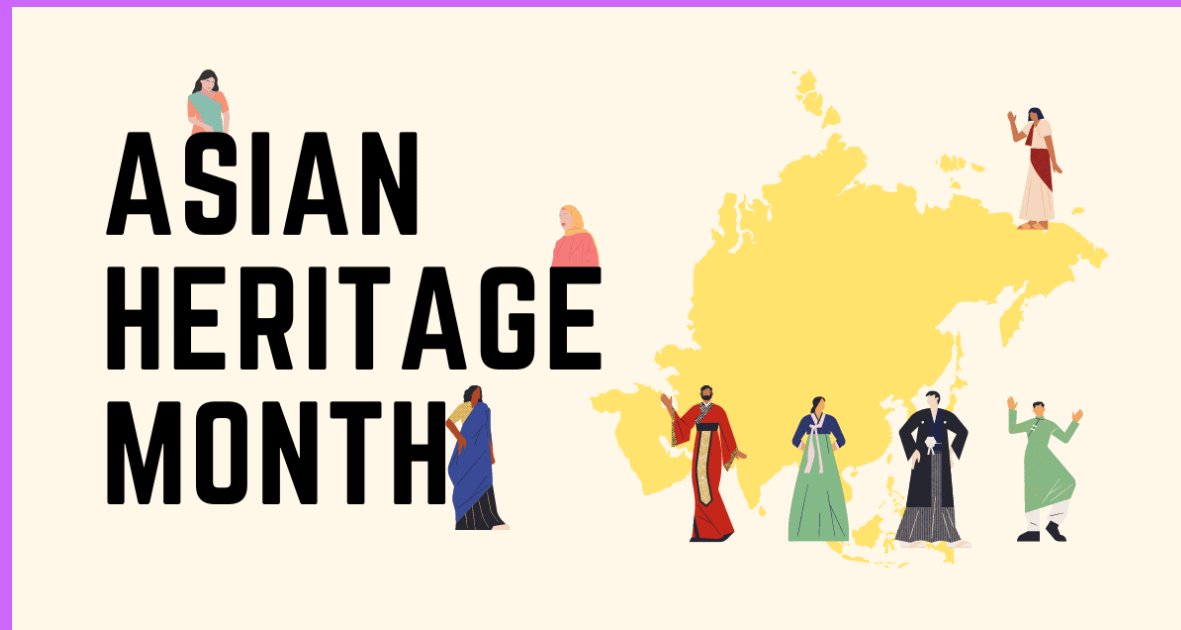
- International Day Against Homophobia, Transphobia and Biphobia is observed on May 17th.
