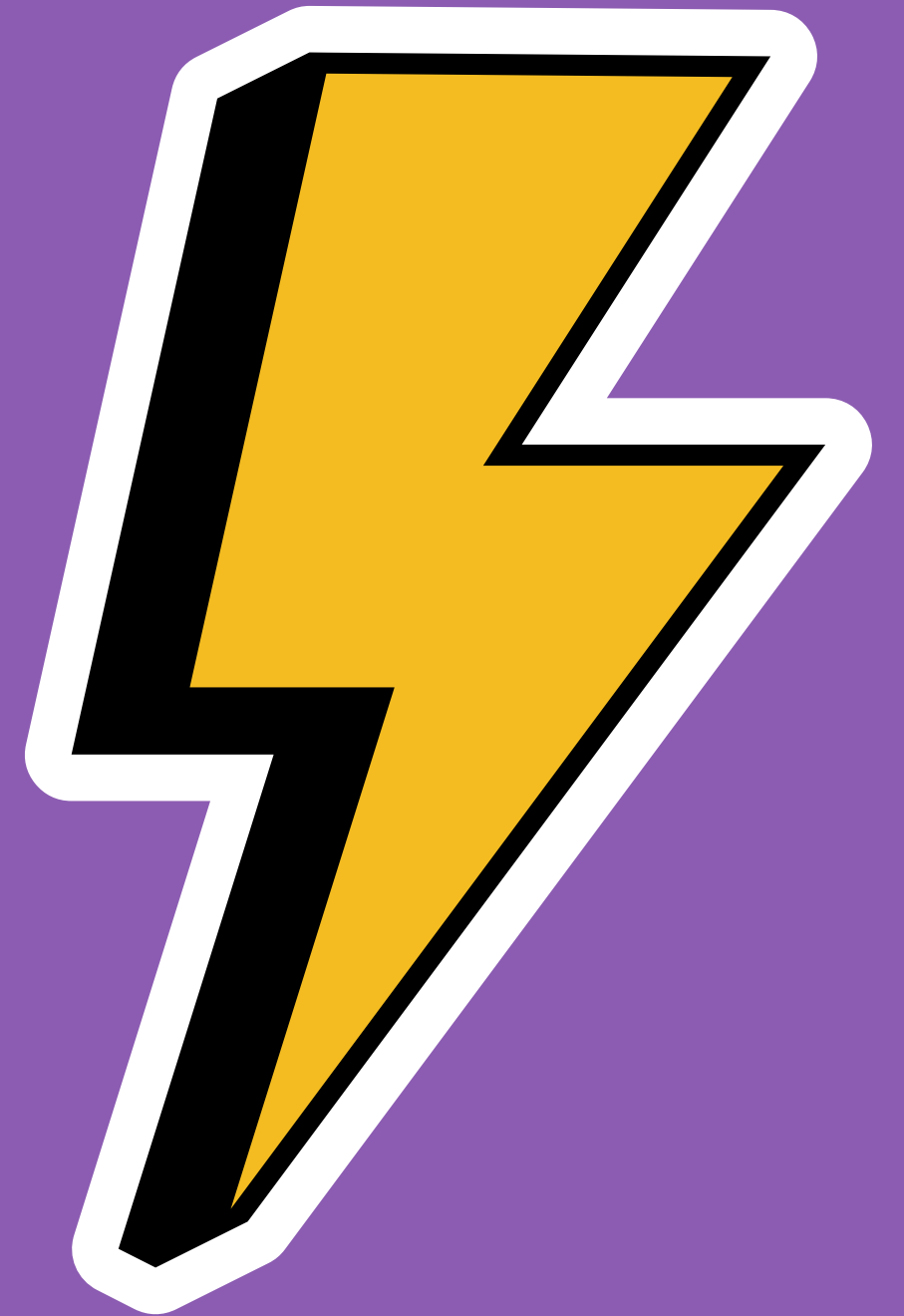

# BREAKFAST & LUNCH OPTIONS

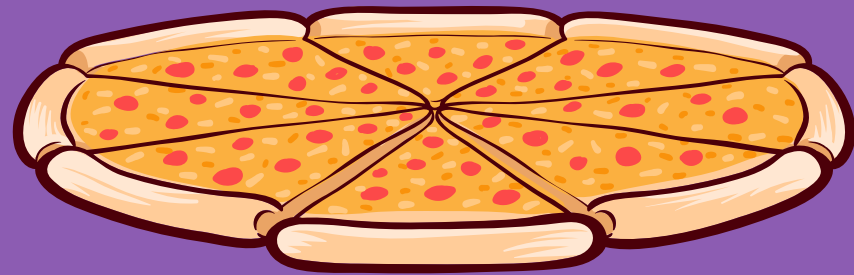
The Breakfast Program is in the lobby from 8:20 - 8:30. Grab a healthy snack to start your day!

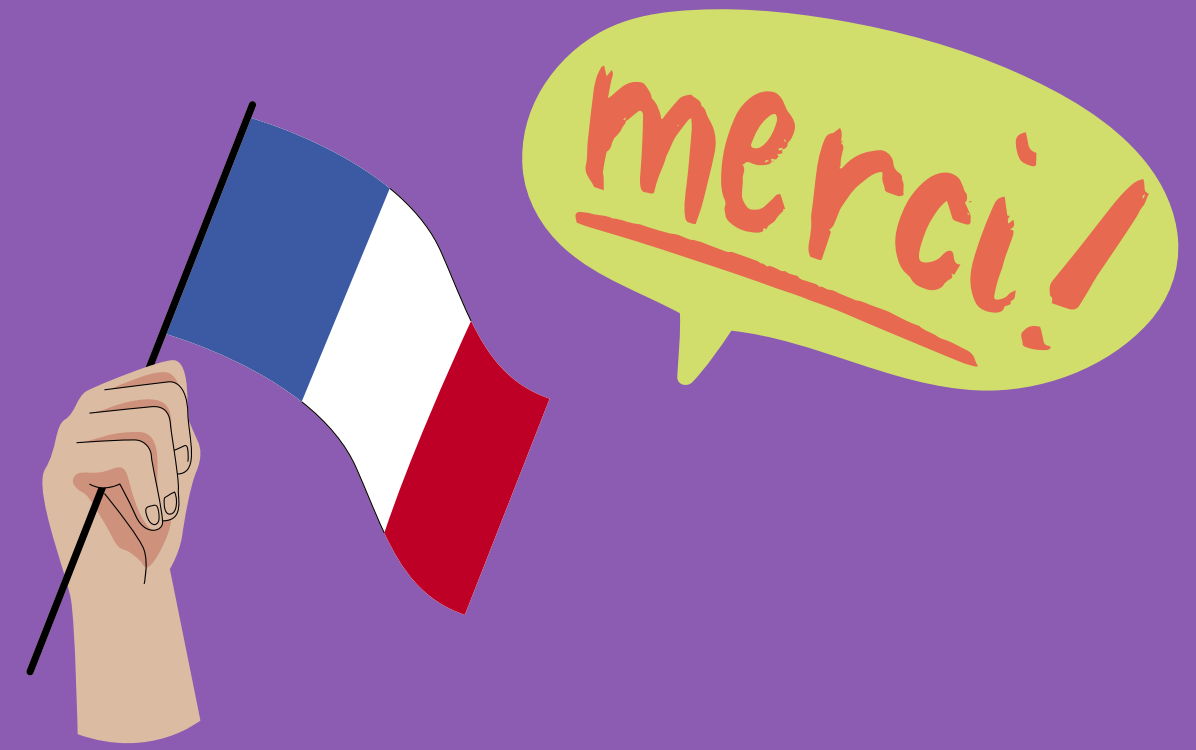
Bring your lunch to the Bolt Center on Wednesdays if you want to hang out with Sonny and Joey, our adorable school pets!
