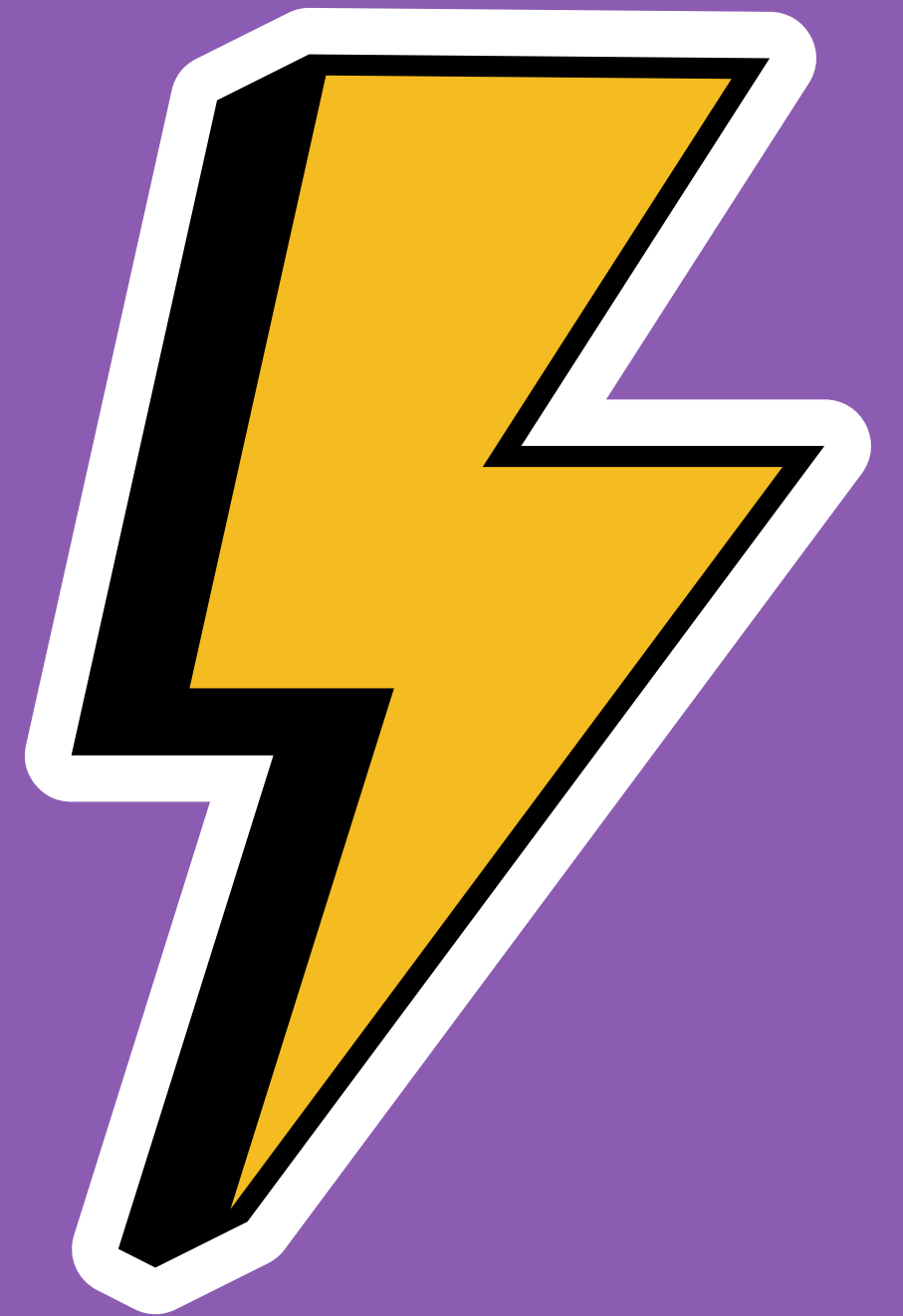

Thursday, Sept 19th from 6:30 - 8:30

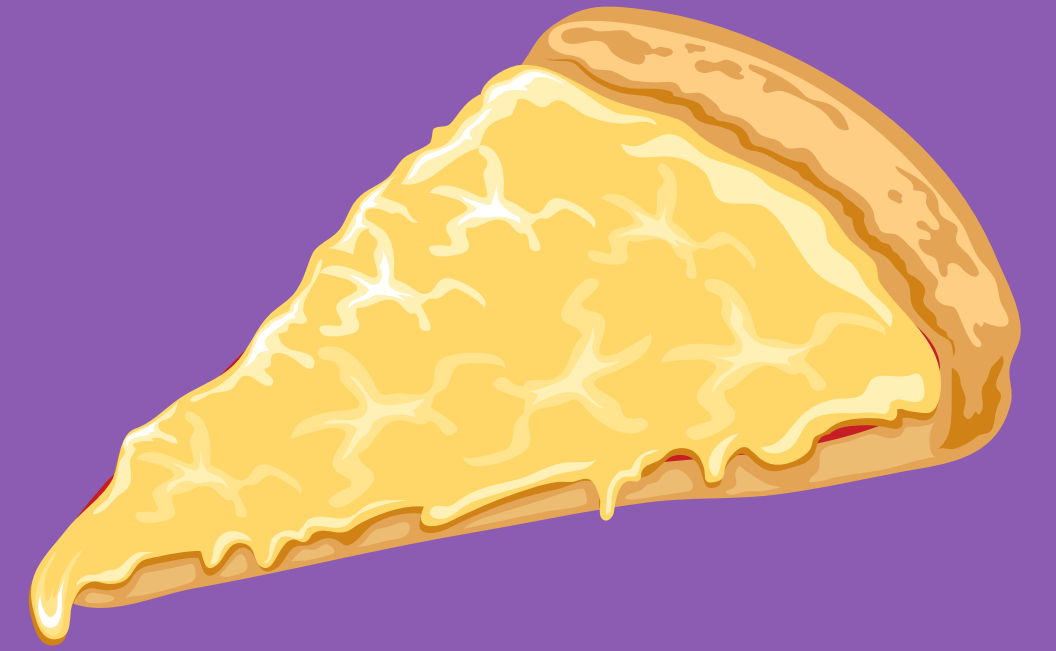

CENTRAL AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE

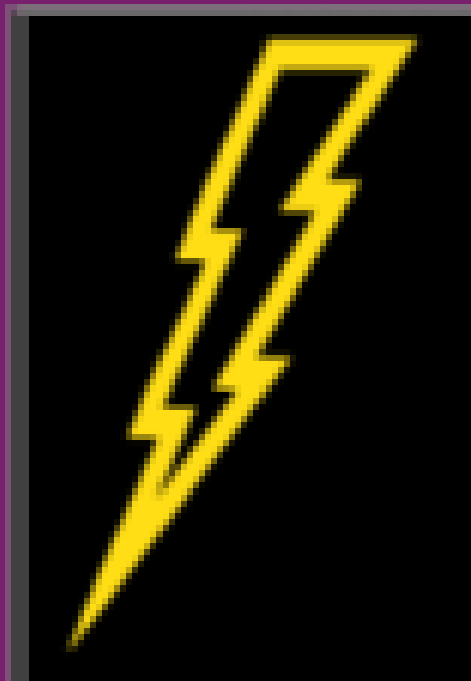

September 15 marks 194 years since a group of Central American *criollos* - the highest social class of the time - declared their independence from Spain's rule.
