Mindful Moment

Here at Bayview School we are working on our mindfulness, where we become present in the moment and learn to control our emotions, which in turn leads to building our self-esteem. Students are learning many ways to gain control of their bodies and their minds. Here are a few activities to share so you could try at home with your child. They work great with adults too!

- Blowing bubbles. To blow a good bubble you need to inhale and exhale slowly!
- Pretend to hold a cup of hot cocoa in front of your body with two hands, close your eyes and breathe deeply in through your nose to smell the chocolate, then exhale out your mouth to cool off the drink.
- Blowing out the candles hold your hand up with your fingers spread wide. Take a deep breath in through your nose to fill your lungs and pretend to blow out each of the candles on your fingers. Exhale slowly through your mouth to release all the air.
