

<u>VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL</u> - <u>All visitors</u> MUST report to the office to sign in and get a visitors pass. This is an essential process to be sure that everyone in the school is safe.

<u>DROP OFF ZONE</u> – There are <u>STILL</u> a few cars parking on the side of school at our drop off zone, **Please**, **please**, **respect** the drop off zone!!!!! There have been many complaints about parents parking their cars and getting out. This cannot happen! The area at the side of the building is for drop off only. Just drive up, let your child out and drive away. If you need to walk your child up or come into the building, please park down in the lower parking lot by the basketball courts. I need the drop off zone to run smoothly so all students – YOUR CHILDREN – are safe.

BAYVIEW SCHOOL TIMETABLE - We would like all students to be in the building by 8:15am so they are ready to begin promptly at 8:20am. This may seem like a lot to ask, but in order for there to the greatest opportunity for learning to occur, students are **EXPECTED** here on time. It is a disruption for the teacher, student and class when a student arrives late.

IMPORTANT – Absolutely under no circumstances should your child be dropped off prior to 8:05am. No one is available to supervise them.

END OF DAY DISMISSAL - All students must be consistent with what their routine is after school. Either the student takes the bus every day or they walk every day. Students will not be allowed to decide if they walk or take a bus depending on the day or weather. Transportation requires us to be consistent so we know our students are safe.
