Lettuce, cheese, mustard or mayo

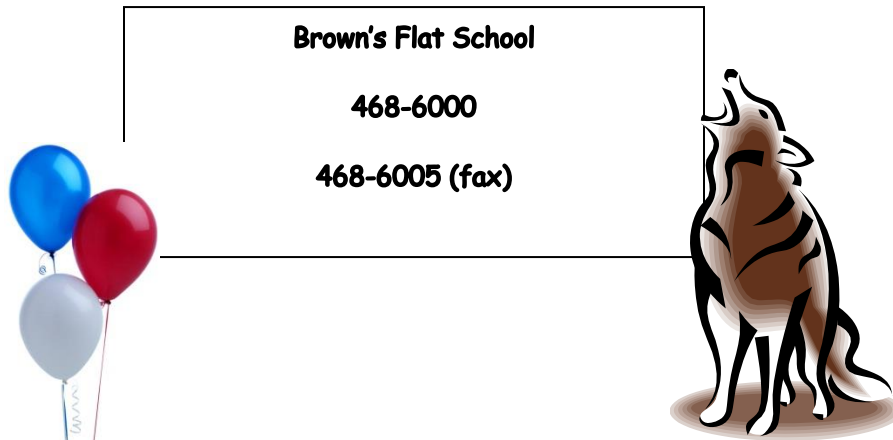
Order forms will be sent home on Monday as orders must be in by **Tuesday**.
