We are so very excited to be welcoming all Stingers back for in-school learning! Here are a few reminders to help our re-entry go smoothly:

Student drop-off and pick-up: Students should be dropped off and picked up at the rear of the building off of Visart St. Parking at the front of the building is very limited and unnecessary vehicles cause congestion and safety issues. We appreciate you keeping these spaces available to staff.

Screening for Covid-19 Symptoms: According to the Winter Plan for K-8 Schools, students and school personnel will screen for symptoms at home every day. They will screen for symptoms such as fever, cough, runny nose or any other symptoms that may have developed or worsened. If a new or worsening symptom develops, a student or a school personnel is not permitted to attend school until they have a negative point-of-care-test (POCT).

Masks: Masks must be worn by all staff and students at all times except when seated and eating or drinking. It is very important that masks are well fitted and cover both mouth and nose. Please verify that your child's masks stays up over their nose and fits snug to their face. In addition, students should be coming to school with at least 2 masks and they need to have one on when entering the building.

Winter Gear: Be sure to dress your child for the weather! As per district policy, students will enjoy recess times outside unless the temperature drops below -20 degree Celsius.
