## LEVEL 2

Behaviors that:

Interfere with the educational environment
Put others at risk or harm
May require administrator involvement

Are **Chronic** Level 1 behaviors

Disrespect to adults or peers (talking back, gestures, etc)	Parent Contacted
Leaving assigned area without permission	Problem solving worksheet
Talking	Send discipline note home
Inappropriate language/noises	Lunch detention
Throwing things	Loss of privileges
Cheating	Time out in another teacher's room
Lying	Restitution
Vandalism/Destruction/Minor theft	Re-teach/practice expectation
Not keeping hands, feet, and other objects to yourself	Team meeting with student

## LEVEL 3

Behaviors that:

Violate Policy 703 (Section 6.3 and/or 6.4)

Are Chronic Level 2 Behaviors

Require administrative involvement

Behaviors may include:	Consequences may include:

Having or using Weapons	Parent/student/principal conference
Having or using Drugs	District Referral
Major theft/Major vandalism	ISS (In school suspension)
Bullying	OSS (Out of school suspension – last resort)
Inappropriate abusive or discriminatory language	Loss of privilege (not allowed to attend after school act.)
Leaving the building without permission	Possible referral to Systems of Care (SD, School
Verbal/nonverbal intimidation	Psych, Mental Health, SSE)
Sexual harassment	Restitution
Spitting	Report filed with Police.
Other behaviors that may be deemed unsafe/illegal	Consultation with Community Police Officer
