- ST. STEPHEN EDUCATION CENTRE (Formerly School District 10)
- HAMPTON EDUCATION CENTRE (Formerly School District 6)
- SAINT JOHN EDUCATION CENTRE (Formerly School District 8)

STUDENTS [GRADES K – 9]:

Students in Grades K to 9 in the public education system in the former School District's 6, 8 and 10 will begin the 2012-2013 school year on WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 5th.

PLEASE NOTE: ST. STEPHEN EDUCATION CENTRE (Formerly School District 10)

A staggered entry will be used for ST. STEPHEN MIDDLE SCHOOL as follows:

- September 5 Grade 6 students only
- September 6 All students

A staggered entry will be used for ST. STEPHEN HIGH SCHOOL as follows:

- September 5 Grade 9 students only
- September 6 All students

A staggered entry will be used for FUNDY HIGH SCHOOL as follows:

- September 5 Grade 7 and 9 students only
- September 6 All students

PLEASE NOTE SAINT JOHN EDUCATION CENTRE (Formerly School District 8)

STUDENTS [GRADES 10 - 12]:

A staggered entry will be used for former District 8 high schools as follows:

- September 5 Grade 9 students only
- September 6 Grade 10,11 and 12 students only
- September 7 All students

PLEASE NOTE: HAMPTON EDUCATION CENTRE (Formerly School District 6)

Kindergarten students begin on a staggered entry the first week. If you do not have an assigned time, please call your school after August 20th.

PLEASE NOTE: HAMPTON & SAINT JOHN EDUCATION CENTRES

School District officials will send home busing arrangements prior to the start of the 2012-2013 school year for the following grade levels: Kindergarten, three, six and nine. The remainder of the students will have the same busing arrangements as the previous year unless otherwise notified through a letter from your local Education Centre.

TEACHERS:

Teachers and school administrators will be involved in administrative and professional learning activities from August 27th to the 30th inclusive and September 4th.

TRANSPORTATION:

For Saint John Education Centre Schools only - City Transit student bus passes will be available at school commencing the first day of classes. Passes are not available at the Saint John Education Centre. Students must sign for a City Transit bus pass and assume responsibility for it.
