Teaching Children Positive And Effective Strategies

For Dealing With Bullies

"The Bully And The Purple Pants" is a dynamic, interactive program for elementary school children. Through the use of songs, stories and role-playing, Parents' Choice award-winning singer and educator Paul Behnke teaches children strategies for dealing with Bullies. Paul draws from leading researchers when he teaches children how to identify and deal with a variety of bullying behaviors. Physical, emotional and verbal bullying are addressed during Paul's program.

Paul focuses on three main areas during his program:

- 1) The characteristics of a bully
- 2) How to avoid being an easy target for a bully
- 3) How to respond positively and effectively to bullies

Paul draws on many of the strategies put forth by leading researchers in this area. For example, students learn about..

- The importance of not getting involved with bullies in any kind of physical interchange
- Walking away from a bully and ignoring the bully (if possible)
- Telling a teacher or another trusted adult when being bullied
- · How to tell a bully in polite and firm tones not to bother you
- How to keep from reacting emotionally when being bullied

Students come away from Paul's program with many practical strategies for dealing with Bullies.
