What's Coming Up This Month

The Easter Break is a sure sign that we are on the last leg of the school year. As usual, we have a series of different activities coming up in the next few weeks.

- The Grade 5s will have their final PALS in the Park activity next week. Be sure to dress for the weather.
- Choir members will receive a notice regarding the upcoming Music Festival performance on May 29th. Be sure to check your book bags for a notice.
- Our current kindergarten students will be staying home on May 21st in order to allow our kindergartens entering in September 2014 a chance to experience the classroom routine. Current Kindergarten parents have already received notification of the day.
- Havelock students and their families will be participating in the 2014 Provincial Wellness surveys.
