Supply List for Grade 4 French Immersion, 2013-14

- 30 HB pencils (Try to buy North American made. They are better balanced; lead in the center so they last longer and are easier to write with.)
- 1 package of 24 coloured pencils
- Markers non scented
- 4 pens (2 red and 2 blue for editing in LA)
- 3 black, dry-erase markers
- 4 white erasers
- 4 LARGE glue STICKS (Please NO LIQUID glue!)
- 1 pair of scissors (No rounded tips please. There is more precision cutting now.)
- 1 metric ruler (Centimetres NOT inches so buy it in Canada.)
- 1 deck of cards
- 1 package of 40-page notebooks (4 pack) (NO WIRE SPIRALS PLEASE.)
- 300 sheets of loose leaf
- 16 duo-tangs covers
- 1 hard-covered COMPOSITION book
- 1 two pocket folder
- 1 scrap book (Coil type with dimensions of 25.6 x 27.9 cm.)
- 50 sheets of construction paper in various colours.
- 1 boxes of Kleenex.
- 1 box of large Ziploc bags
- 1 box of small Ziploc bags
- 1 pair of headphones (dollar store)

Please Note: Items like pencils, pens and erasers frequently need to be replenished and depending upon the quality of the item and care the student takes with their supplies, more might need to be sent in during the school year.

Please be aware that some supplies are placed in a common area for everyone to use (ex. Bucket of scissors or pencils).

While a second pair of sneakers does not have to be purchased and left at school, students need a pair of sneakers to wear in the gym during physical education as per the Provincial Physical Education Safety guidelines.

All school supplies should be unscented as per Provincial Policy.
