- 30 HB pencils (Try to buy North American made. They are better balanced; (lead is in the center so they last longer and are easier to write with.))
- 1 package of 24 coloured pencils
- 1 blue pen (for editing in LA)
- 3 BLACK, dry-erase markers
- 2 highlighters
- 4 white erasers
- 4 <u>LARGE</u> glue STICKS (Please NO LIQUID glue!)
- 1 pair of scissors (No rounded tips please. There is more precision cutting now.)
- 1 deck of cards
- 150-200 sheets of loose leaf
- 4 PLASTIC duo-tangs; (red, yellow, blue, and green, if possible)
- 6 regular duo-tangs covers (One each of the following colours: <u>orange, yellow, green, blue, red, and black</u> to help your child stay organized.)
- 1 hard-covered COMPOSITION book
