- 30 HB pencils

(Try to buy North American made. They are better balanced; lead in the center so they last longer and are easier to write with.)

- 1 package of 24 coloured pencils
- 1 package of markers (for projects)
- 2 pens (for editing in LA)
- 3 black, dry-erase markers
- 2 highlighters
- 4 <u>white</u> erasers
- 4 LARGE glue STICKS (Please NO LIQUID glue!)
- 1 pair of scissors (No rounded tips please. There is more precision cutting now.)
- 1 metric ruler (Centimetres NOT inches so buy it in Canada.)
- 30 duo-tangs (for use in both English and French class)
- 50 sheets of construction paper in various colours.
- 1 Composition book (hard cover notebook can be found at dollarstores)
- 1 legal size fabric pouch with a zipper (dollarstore)
- 1 flash drive (1 GB or higher)
- **1 scrap book** (Coil type with dimensions of 25.6 x 27.9 cm.)
- 1 deck of cards
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 pkg. large Ziploc bags
- 1 pkg. small Ziploc bags
- 1 pair of headphones
