Course Registration

Course registration is the opportunity for students to select which courses they would like to study in the **2023-2024** year.

Effort is made to ensure students receive their first choices; however, schedules are created based on enrollment, individual course selections, and teacher availability. Courses that have only one section offered add an additional layer of difficulty for timetables.

Alternate selections are used in lieu of unavailable courses or courses not aligned with the student's other compulsory courses.

It is important to carefully consider your alternates when selecting courses.

Important Information for Students entering Grade 10: New graduation guidelines: Core Differences

- 1) Students entering Grade 10 are moving away from a one credit/course system to a **credit hour system**.
- 2) Students are required to accumulate **100 credit hours** to apply for graduation.
- 3) Students entering Grade 10 now require 12 Math Credit Hours (3 math courses) to graduate: GMF 10 **PLUS** two additional math classes.
- 4) Increased opportunity to count **Local Options** towards graduation: students can now take up to 20 Credit Hours (five local option courses) and count them towards their 20 flexible Credit Hours.



Graduation Requirements:

As of June 2026, graduates must achieve the following:



Have met the learning requirements prescribed in the grade 9 Curriculum



Have completed compulsory credit hours in grades 10 through 12

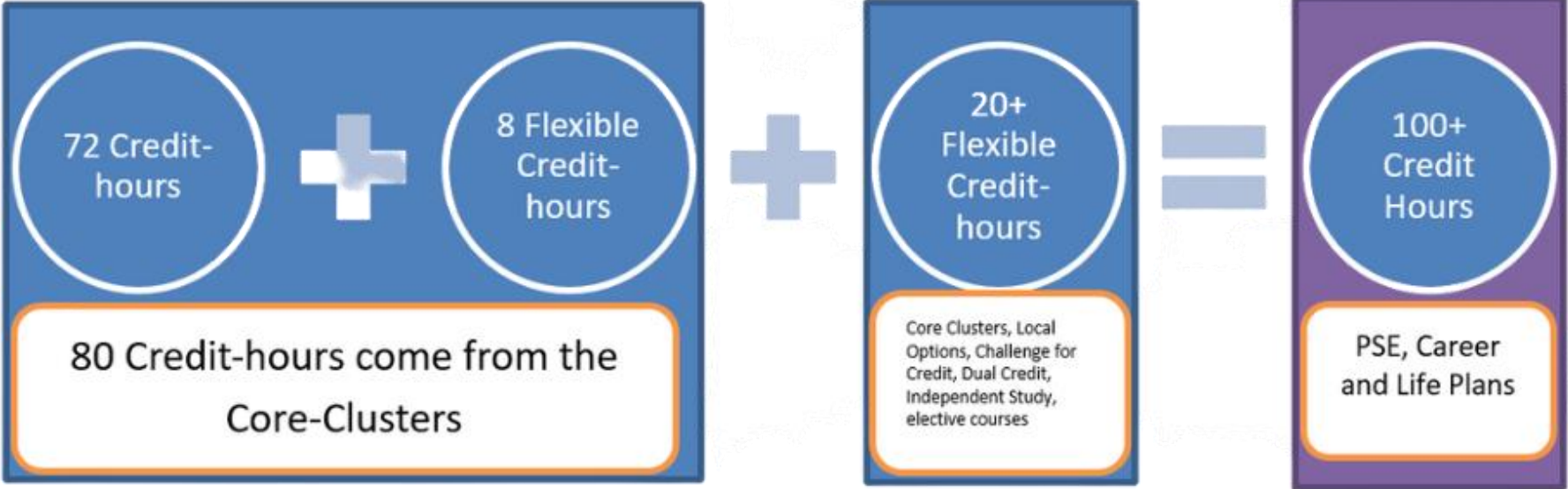


Have accumulated **100 CREDIT HOURS** to apply for graduation



Have developed a documented career-life plan in **myBlueprint**

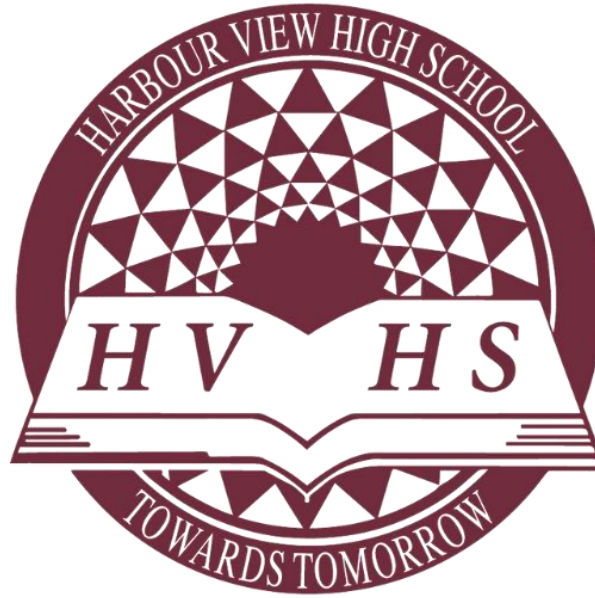

- **English Language Arts 10** Courses are now called “ELA 10 Foundations” and ELPA 10 Extended”
- Courses can only meet the requirements of a **single cluster**
- **Personal interest courses** can be used by schools to support meeting cluster requirements
- Students can take up to 20 credit hours (5 classes!) towards their 20 flexible credit hours
- Grades 10, 11, and 12 courses will –
 - Be listed on the transcript
 - Include a mark on the 100% scale. In select courses, a Pass may replace 60% or higher.
 - Show 4 credit hours, unless another credit-hour value has been approved

Important Information for Students entering Grade 11

- 1) There are two separate English 11 courses. **Students must select both** English Literary Texts and English Informational Texts.
- 2) 18 credits are needed to graduate.
- 3) French Immersion students require 5 courses** in French Immersion for graduation purposes.
- 4) If you plan on taking Outdoor Education, you must pick up a form from Guidance and return it to your HR teacher with your registration form.
- 5) If you plan on taking an AP course and are interested in having a Study Hall, please see Mrs. Brown for an application.



Important Information for Students entering Grade 12

- 1) 18 credits are needed to graduate.
- 2) **French Immersion students require 5 courses** in French Immersion for graduation purposes.
- 3) If you plan on taking Outdoor Education, you must pick up form from Guidance and return to HR teacher with your registration form.
- 4) If you plan on taking an AP course and are interested in having a Study Hall, please see Mrs. Brown for an application.
- 5) Students signing up for Coop 120 are not guaranteed acceptance. A selection process, based on attendance and behaviour, will take place once course selection has ended.
If you plan on taking Coop, you must pick up forms from Guidance and return to your HR teacher with your registration form. Forms must be submitted on time.

Registration Process

- Attend homeroom to gain additional information and support about your course selection options
- Confirm your course selections with your homeroom teacher; your teacher will sign your registration form
- Bring your form home to your family for approval and signing
- Return your form to your HR teacher
- Bring your device, log in to PowerSchool during extended HR, and follow your teacher's instructions for self-registering for your 2023-2024 courses!

***Make sure you know how to connect your laptop to the wifi, and can sign into PowerSchool.**

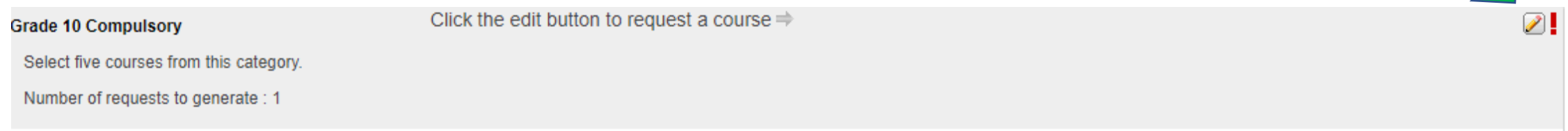
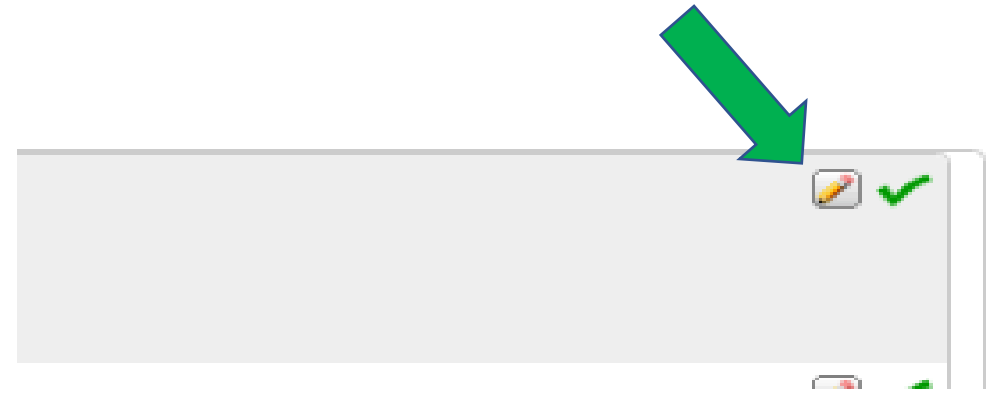

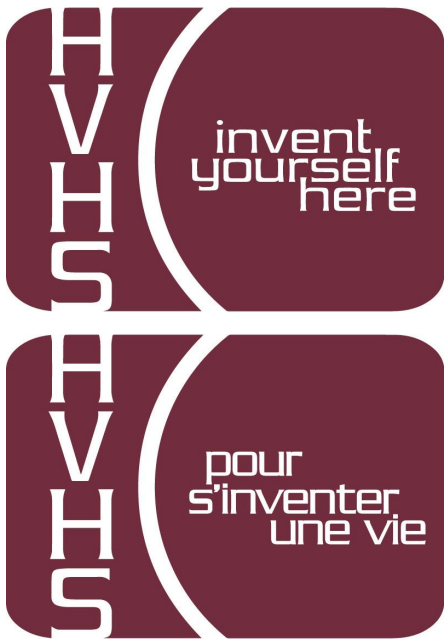

It is important to note***

Total Credit hours for **Grade 10 students can choose up to 3 (plus one alternate)**, unless they are repeating a course at the grade 9 level or if they are taking AP Computer Science Principals as a specialty.

Total Credit hours for **Grade 11 students should be 10 (plus two alternates)**, unless they are repeating a course at the grade 10 level.

Total Credit hours requested for **Grade 12 students should be 10 (plus two alternates)**.
