- September**
- Classroom presentations regarding post-secondary education conducted through English classes.
 - Grade 12 interviews begin.
 - New Brunswick Community College website www.nbcc.nb.ca **Students that have not applied during their grade 11 year should do so as soon as possible.** Students are admitted on a First Qualified, First Accepted Basis.
 - The web site for information and application to **Ontario universities** is www.ouac.on.ca. Students should apply **prior to January 13th**. Information on **Ontario colleges** can be found at www.ontariocolleges.ca Students must apply **prior to February 1st**.

REMINDER - NBCC Applications !!!!!

- December**
- **Application Information Package** distributed to Grade 12 students.
 - It is a really excellent idea for honours/high honours students to prepare an **Activity Summary** to accompany university and scholarship applications.
 - Application forms for post-secondary institutions are available On-line and from the Guidance Department. It is a good idea to complete these over the Christmas break.
 - **The only test date in Saint John for the SAT is January 23rd, 2016.**
(Students must register by December 28th)
- January-**
- **January 13th.** Recommended deadline for applications to **Ontario** Universities, however, please refer to the specific institution for full details.
 - **Examinations.** Early acceptance to universities, community colleges, and many scholarships depend largely on these results.
 - Check information package to be sure you know, for your particular institution:
 - application procedure
 - fees
 - scholarships, etc.
 - Make “official” requests to the Guidance Department regarding the forwarding of **transcripts**.
- February**
- **On-Site admissions to UNBSJ / UNBF.** (Tentatively **February 8th**)
Representatives from the Admissions Offices of UNB will be in the Guidance Office to accept and process student applications. Students will make appointments and will know within minutes whether they have been accepted to most programs.
 - Applications to post-secondary institutions, other than UNBSJ, should be mailed by the student or completed on-line.
 - Scholarship and Bursary information and application forms are available in the guidance office. Students should check the scholarship boards and TV in the Guidance Center on a regular basis. Have your parents/guardians check with their place of employment, trade union, community groups (Knights of Columbus, Legion, Kiwanis, etc.) to see if they sponsor scholarships or bursaries that you may apply for.
 - Universities such as Dalhousie, St. Mary’s, Memorial, UNB Fredericton, etc. host information and registration sessions in Saint John, usually at one of the uptown hotels. Details will be passed on once these dates become available.
- March**
- **March 1 – UNB Entrance Scholarships Due** (On line application must be completed to be considered). Be sure to include your Activity Summary.
 - March 1st is a common deadline for some university and college applications, but not all, so refer to specific websites for further clarification. Continue to check the scholarship boards.
 - Post-secondary visitations are excellent ways to finalize your choices and to become familiar with your future school.
- April/May**
- Local bursaries and scholarship applications available in the Guidance office.
 - Student Loan information available on line www.studentaid.gnb.ca.
 - Students should begin receiving acceptance notices and scholarship offers from post-secondary institutions.
 - Student Employment Center opens on Prince William Street. Register for summer employment.
- June**
- Student Loan application forms become available.
 - Final transcripts will be forwarded to post-secondary institutions **provided you have requested transcripts to be sent earlier in the year.**
