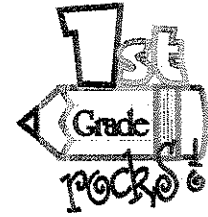
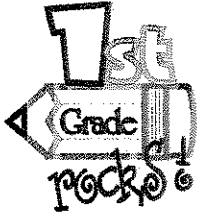

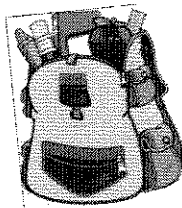

  - o Ziplock baggies – boys bring **large** and girls bring **small**.

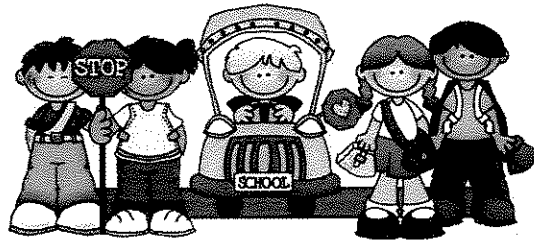




## 2018-19 **Grade 3 School Supply List**
