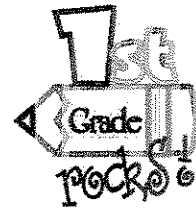
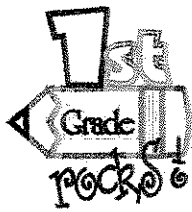

Hello wonderful first graders and families!

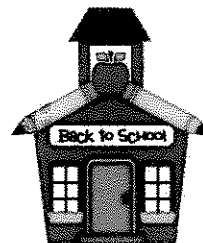
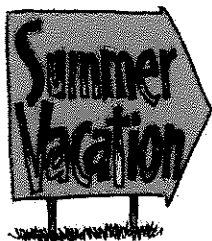
With another school year already in our thoughts we would like to extend our well wishes to all families and we look forward to working together with you, to help make your first grader's year a positive learning experience.

Since it has worked out so well the past few years we have decided to request a **Supply Fee of \$40** (cash only please) in lieu of asking you to go out and purchase the items needed for your child's first grade year. These supplies include some of the following items: pencils, erasers, crayons, white glue, glue sticks, scissors, duo tangs, looseleaf, double pocket writing folders, Hilroy notebooks, writing journals (1/2 lined), Ziploc baggies, etc. and whatever else will be needed. This will cover all supplies until year-end.

In the past we have had some parents have difficulty finding particular items or have their child bring in items that are not suitable for the purpose needed. This way we can pool our supplies and we will be able to have fresh supplies for everyone throughout the year.

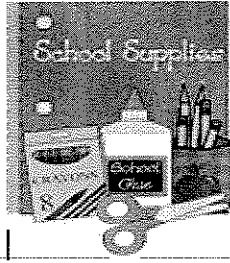

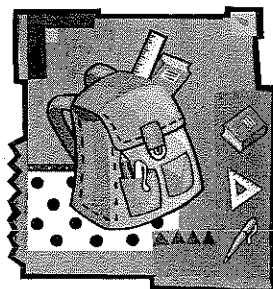
