Hello amazing kindergarteners and families!

We are very pleased to welcome you to LHS for the 2023-24 school year. We are looking forward to working with you and your child to make this first year of school a wonderful learning experience!

Our school hours are 8:05 - 1:45. We have recess from 10:00 - 10:15 and lunch from 11:50 - 12:25. Students being dropped off out back may arrive at 7:45, enter the building and get ready for the school day. When the bells rings at 8:15 am, our learning time begins. Therefore, it is very important that your child is at school prior to 8:15am. Your child will need a snack for recess and a lunch (please be advised that Lakewood Heights School is a Nut free school). You may want to have your child practice eating (as well as opening) a snack and lunch from their lunch bag at some point during the summer (they have 20 minutes to eat lunch).

We will be having an Open House on Thursday, August 31st from 5:00 - 6:00. At this time, you and your child will come to our classroom to meet the teacher and drop off anything that will help lighten the book bag and make your child's first day run smoothly.

We will have a staggered entry in Kindergarten. This means that half of the students attend school on Tuesday, September 5th and the other half will attend school on Wednesday, September 6th.

All students will attend school on Thursday, September 7th.

Your child will come to school on Wednesday, September 6th.

On your child's first day of school you are asked to bring your child in to our classroom between 8:10-8:15. Please fill out our first day of school (information) form and if necessary, stay for a few moments to see that your child is settled.

<u>School Supplies:</u> We are asking that each family register through our cashless school program http://asd-s.schoolcashonline.com to pay the \$50 school supply fee. We will do the shopping for you during the summer months! The \$50 will cover the cost of duo tangs, notebooks, scissors, crayons, markers, pencil crayons, erasers, pencils, writing folders, various kinds of paper, glue and other supplies necessary for learning.

Your child will also need a pair of sneakers for gym (Velcro), a lunch bag, backpack (large enough to hold their homework pouch and a lunch bag) and two boxes of tissue. Please remember to <u>put your child's name</u> on all of these items. Your child will also need a complete change of clothes to be kept in the class in case of spills or accidents. Please put these items in a bag with your child's name on it. <u>Be sure to put your child's name on all their belongings.</u>

GRADE ONE SUPPLY LIST - 2023/2024

Hello wonderful first graders and families!

With another school year already in our thoughts, we would like to extend our well wishes to all families and we look forward to working together with you to help make your first grader's year a positive learning experience. Since it has worked out so well the past few years, we have decided to request a <u>Supply Fee of \$50</u> (paid on Cashless Schools) in lieu of asking you to go out and purchase the items needed for your child's first grade year. These supplies include some of the following items: pencils, erasers, crayons, dry erase markers, white glue, glue sticks, scissors, duotangs, double pocket writing folders, writing journals (1/2 lined), Ziploc baggies, etc. and whatever else will be needed. This will cover all supplies until year-end.

In the past we have had some parents have difficulty finding particular items or have their child bring in items that are not suitable for the purpose needed. This way, we can pool our supplies and we will be able to have fresh supplies for everyone throughout the year.

We are asking that parents please send in 2 boxes of Kleenex/tissue and a pair of sneakers they will need to use in the gym. *We ask that unless your child can tie their sneakers with ease independently, please send Velcro sneakers for indoor (gym) shoes. Of course, a fairly large, sturdy backpack and lunch bag will be necessary. Please remember to put their name on both items.


