**Tuesday, October 15 - Friday, October 18, 2019**

Children born in **2015** will start school in **September 2020**.

### **K**ick-Off to Kindergarten Event

**October/November**

Parents are invited to their community school for an information session regarding your child's transition to school. There will also be information about the Early Years Evaluation - Direct Assessment (EYE-DA). Information will be provided about supporting your child's development in these important months before starting school, about upcoming events, and parents will have the chance to ask questions about school readiness and expectations.

## Welcome to Kindergarten Event January - February

Parents and children are invited to attend an exciting and interactive event at their community school. Both children and parents will participate in learning centres related to school readiness skills, listen to stories, have a snack, and meet the kindergarten teachers from their school.

## Early Years Evaluation - Direct Assessment (EYE-DA) - October - February

The EYE-DA is an assessment that measures a child's kindergarten readiness skills. All children in the province of New Brunswick entering kindergarten in September 2020 will participate in this assessment. This information will help guide you in preparing your child for school and help the school prepare relevant supports for your child.

**Family and Child Education Anglophone South** have been contracted to assess children with the EYE-DA and provide follow-up with children and parents. Parents will be given an appointment when registering their child for school. Enter appointment time and location given here: Tuesday, Nov. 5th & Wednesday, Nov. 6th.



## Kindergarten Orientation Day - May-June

Your child is invited to visit a kindergarten classroom at their school. Children will participate in kindergarten activities and will have the chance to discover what a kindergarten classroom is all about. While the children are visiting the classrooms, parents will participate in school workshops given by literacy mentors, guidance counselors, nutrition consultants, and public health specialists. Also at this time, children and parents will participate in a bus tour and a bus safety discussion with a member of the district transportation team.
