Good Afternoon:

This is Greg Norton calling from Loch Lomond School, with a few updates regarding upcoming events at Loch Lomond School for Monday, April 26th – Friday, April 30th.

This is to inform you that the recent suspension of community use of schools **does not include outdoor fields**. Access to outdoor fields is still permitted under the following conditions:

- Outdoor fields may be used by community organizations subject to district direction, but users may not enter the school building.
- Priority will be given to organizations that involve children and students.
- If cleaning is required, it will meet the COVID-19 school operational plan.
- School districts may contract field bookings out to municipalities if they have an agreement in place.
- Any community organization who uses school outdoor fields will meet Public Health's directives.
- If at any time, the school has one case of COVID-19, the use of outdoor fields will be suspended.
- Use of outdoor fields will also be suspended if the school is in an area under a red or lockdown alert status.

Tuesday, April 27th, every homeroom class will CELEBRATE a classmate as we present our monthly "ROAR Award" certificates. These special student recognition awards celebrate deserving students who best exemplify our ROAR motto – "Respecting Others & Accepting Responsibility." Certificate recipients are also consistently kind, ready to learn and participate positively.
