During the lockdown drill, classroom doors are secured, and the students remain inside the room until instructed by the teacher to resume their activities. All exterior doors are locked, and no one is permitted to enter or leave the building. The safety and security of our students and staff is a top priority for Loch Lomond School and practicing these drills helps ensure our school remains a safe place for teaching and learning.

Parents/Caregivers of students entering Kindergarten for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year are asked to reserve the date of Thursday, June 10th for the Loch Lomond School Kindergarten Orientation Day. Details for the orientation day will be made available soon, however this message serves as a reserve the date notice. Children attending Kindergarten for the upcoming school year will participate in kindergarten orientation activities and will have the chance to discover what a kindergarten day is all about. The orientation session will also provide students and a parent/caregiver opportunity to participate in a bus ride and a bus safety orientation with a member of the district transportation team. In advance, parents/caregivers are reminded of the following:

- Pre-registration will be required and made available soon.
- Kindergarten Orientation Sessions are limited to ten participants per session.
- Parents/Caregivers are not permitted to attend the Kindergarten Orientation Session with their child.
- One Parent/Caregiver is permitted to attend the Bus Ride & Safety Orientation Session.
- AIS (Autism Intervention Services) representative is permitted to attend with their student client.
- All participating students are required to wear masks as per GNB requirements for children over two.
