Student achievement level will reflect that most recent success. As a reminder the 1-4 achievement scale is briefly described as follows:

- 1 = Working Below Learning Outcomes
- 2 = Approaching Learning Outcomes
- 3 = Meeting Learning Outcomes
- 4 = Excelling at Learning Outcomes
