Orange Phase STUDENT MASK REQUIREMENTS



Grades K-8

Must wear a mask at all times at school, except when sitting at a desk working silently, eating, or engaged in sports or during phys ed class. This includes outside.

Grades 9-12

Must wear masks at all times at school, except when eating, engaged in sports activities or during phys ed class. This includes outside.

Grades K-12

Must wear a mask on a **school bus**, even when sitting alone or with a member of the same household.
